*\*Some flowers in particular to be AVOIDED are: azalea, crocus, daffodil, foxglove, oleander, rhododendron, jack-in-the-pulpit, lily of the valley, butterfly weed, clematis, morning glory, periwinkle (vinca), mistletoe, poppy, deadly nightshade, hyacinth, hydrangea, and wisteria.*

*This list is NOT all-inclusive. Remember that some plants might be safe for some species but not others. Also, be aware that some non-toxic plants can have parts (seeds, fruit, bark, etc.) that are seasonally toxic.*

*When in doubt, leave it out and consult with a Veterinarian.*
